Align teaching with high expectations for learning.

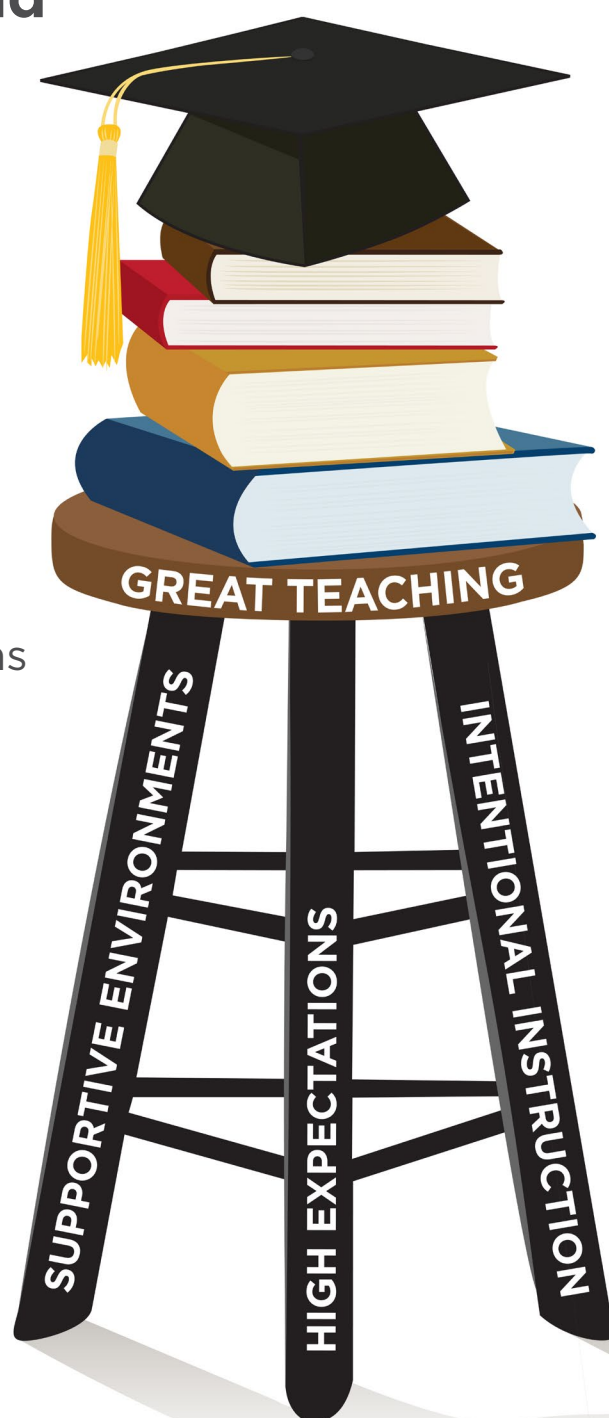
Being demanding is about helping students gain confidence in themselves, and encouraging them to take on more challenges than they previously thought themselves capable of handling.

✓ Use standards to set and guide short- and long-term learning goals.

- Helps students develop critical thinking skills
- Increases student motivation and achievement
- Encourages students to meet high expectations for learning

✓ Create challenging rubrics.

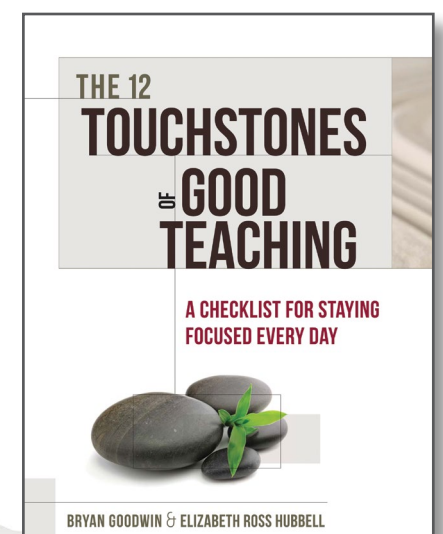
- Helps students identify their current proficiency and then build on it
- Student-created effort rubrics connect students with the “why” of learning and foster student ownership of learning



✓ Provide structure and guidance to clarify learning for students.

- Using KUB statements (Know, Understand, Be able to do) based on standards helps students clarify learning objectives
- Unpacking standards helps students identify big ideas and new opportunities for creativity

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
